- + Designed audio-visual visual presentation, sound reinforcement, and audio-visual control systems for a variety of classroom and meeting rooms that facilitate effective teaching, communication, and collaboration.
- + Worked closely with McMaster University to design teaching stations that effectively prioritized ergonomics for their instructors while integrating audio-visual technology that is both functional and easy-to-use.
