# **UNION PARK**

## **ABOUT THIS PROJECT**

Largest proposed mixed-use development in Toronto's history, including office space, community-serving retail, residential units, and a large park.

- + Located in the heart of downtown Toronto's Entertainment District adjacent to the CN Tower and Rogers Centre.
- + Two residential towers with 800 units across 44-storeys and 54-storeys respectively.
- + Two office towers at 58-storeys and 48-storeys for 3.3-million square feet of office space.
- + Includes approx. 200,000 square feet of retail space within a mixed-use podium.
- + Features three acres of green space, including a winter garden situated between the office towers.
- + Includes a two-acre park built over the Union rail corridor (which is connected to the City of Toronto's future Rail Deck Park).
