

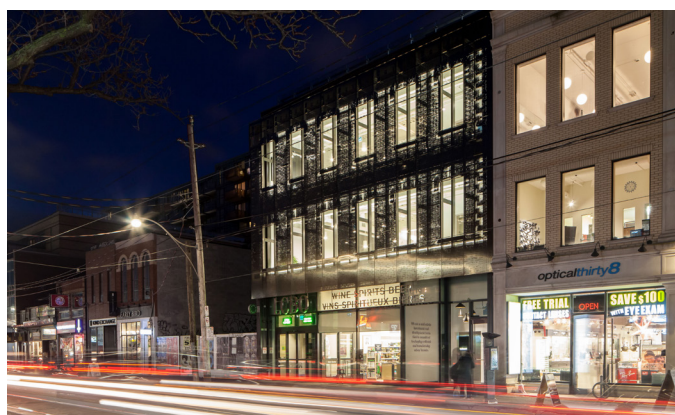
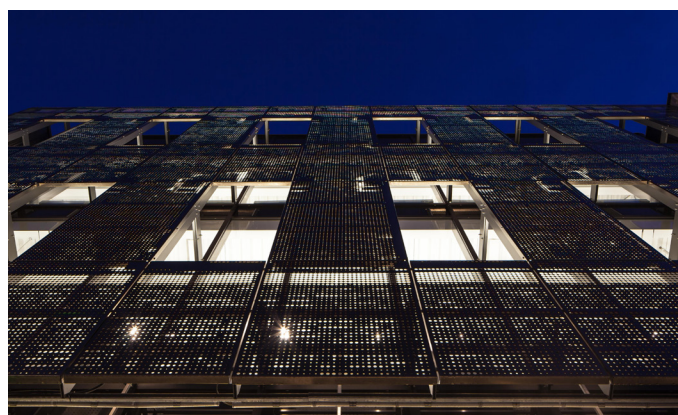
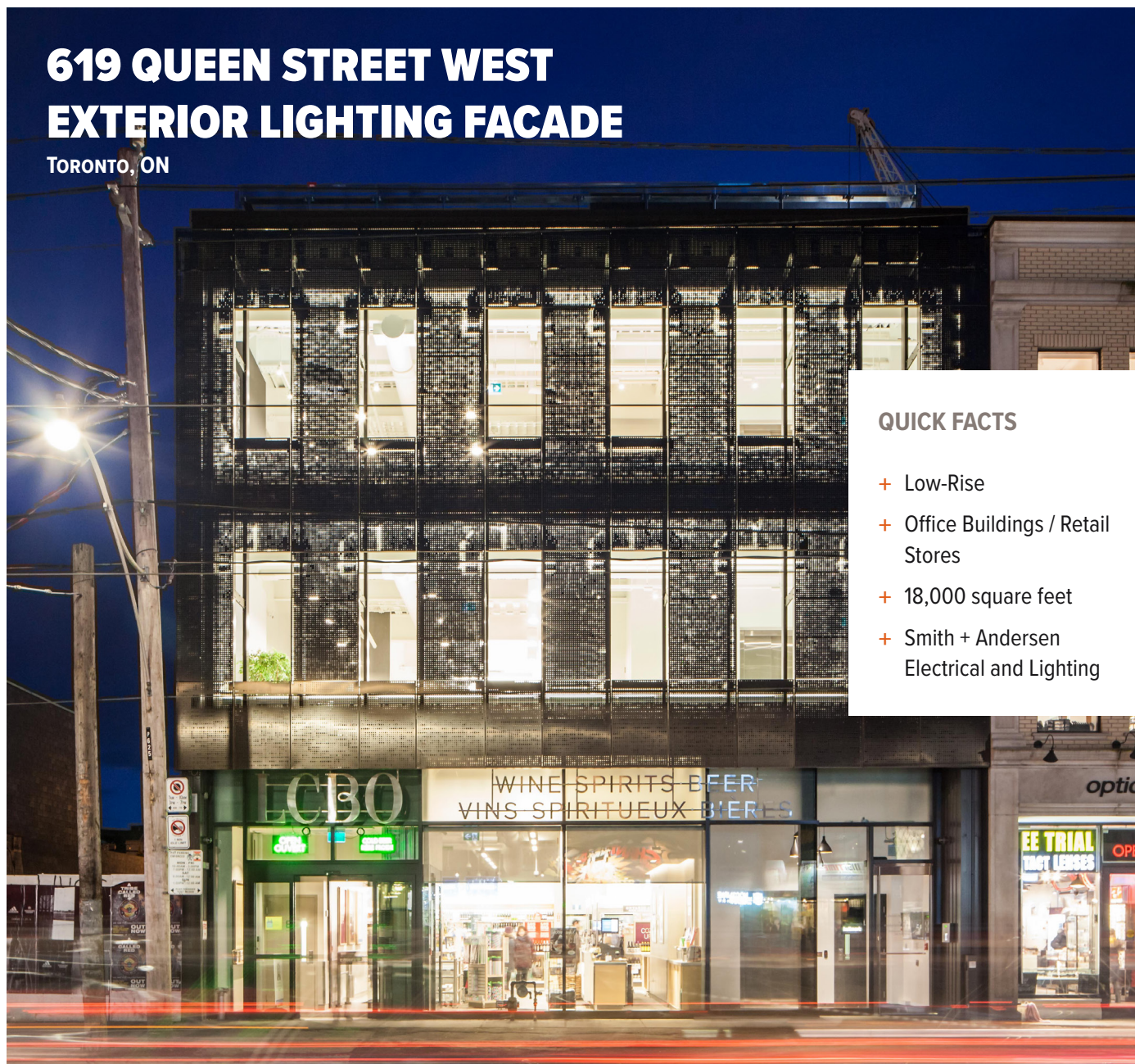

ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Built in 2016, the Hullmark office tower replaced the previous building (destroyed by a fire in 2008).
- + Building design includes a custom-made perforated metal façade, designed to simulate the appearance of a brick exterior, to maintain the historic aesthetic of the neighbourhood.
- + Engaged as the lighting consultant for the project.
- + Lighting design used the interior glazing wall to conceal linear luminaires to create a glow effect through the metal perforations.
- + Leveraged interior lighting since exterior luminaires in this situation are difficult to maintain (due to the tight spacing between the glazing and the overhanging metal structure).
