ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Combined two units from a former office tower to provide a contemporary space while maintaining the art gallery feel throughout.
- + Lighting design incorporated the owner's preferences.
- + To eliminate the visual and psychological effects of heavy smog, treated all perimeter glazing areas to simulate daylight.
- Developed an LED intelligent white system hidden inside the perimeter cove to simulate ambient lighting (can change from warm (2700K) to cool white (6500K), depending on the season, time of day, and outdoor lighting conditions).
- + A semi translucent curtain redirects the lighting in the cove towards the interior area.
- + Decorative LED pendants and downlights (3500K) provide task lighting.
