ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Addition to Archbishop Jordan High School.
- + Two-storey facility featuring a natatorium with four-lane and six-lane, 25-metre lap pools, a leisure pool, kid's teaching pool, whirlpool, as well as a steam room, administration areas, and a wellness centre.
- + Four-lane pool contains a movable floor, in addition to a salt water pool.
- + Used ultra-high efficiency condensing style boilers, air-to-air heat recovery devices (total energy recovery wheels for sanitary and outdoor air, and heat pipes for pool air exhaust and outdoor air), along with variable frequency drives to lower building utility costs.
- + Pool air handling systems rely on the Edmonton climate by employing a pushpull ventilation unit designed to vary the flow of outdoor air into the space to dehumidify as much as ambient conditions will permit.
- + Designed the pool filtration and recirculation systems in accordance with Strathcona County's standard practice (approved vertical sand filtration system with additional flocculation and coagulation agents to improve filtration success and an oxidization agent for improved swimmer comfort).
- + Electrical distribution design integrated all of the modern and efficient systems of the aquatics centre.
