ABOUT THIS PROJECT

+ Acts as the creative focal point of Humber College's Lakeshore campus.

- + Includes the addition of two music and performing arts venues designed to host a variety of arts and entertainment programs, as well as festivals.
- + Scope includes professional-grade multimedia production and post-production facilities, 3D-animation spaces, music labs, a music recording studio, a usability lab, and student residence space.
- + Additional spaces include the Centre for Creative Business Innovation (which adds classrooms and computer lab spaces as well as an Indigenous classroom), retail spaces, a cafeteria, community athletic spaces (including a gymnasium), a rejuvenated campus entrance, a public courtyard, and shared spaces.
- + Integrated project delivery team utilized heavy timber construction.
- + Proposed immersive audio and video technologies for the large performance hall.
- + Designed telecommunications systems which allow for media sharing over a common network through the hub's various broadcast systems.
- + Proposed audio-visual designs that equip the hub with the ability to record audio and video from multiple venues and route to multiple control rooms and destinations (such as a control room, broadcast truck, etc.)


