# SLAVE LAKE LEGACY COMMUNITY CENTRE

## ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Project consists of a two-storey mixed-use community centre situated between C.J. Shurter School and Native Friendship Centre.
- + The community centre features a 500-seat theatre, 300-seat multi-purpose hall, Firesmart Centre, daycare centre, daycare play area on the roof, Elks offices, daycare offices, Red Cross offices, and office space for lease.
- + Two commercial kitchens are located in the facility, one for theatre and hall events, and one for the daycare.
- + Mechanical systems include a low level, low velocity air distribution system for the theatre, VAV in lobby and office areas, and a dedicated ventilation system for the daycare.
- + All areas are heated by a hot water heating system with in-floor heating provided in the theatre and daycare.
- + The facility is capable of operating completely independent of any site services and may operate as an emergency relief facility to house displaced individuals in the event of a natural disaster.
- + Sustainable design principles were upheld.
