ABOUT THIS PROJECT

LOCATION Ottawa, ON

+ Renovations for this shopping centre included back to base building work for the Sears tenant space, general mall renovations, lighting upgrades, and transformation of the existing food court.

SMITH + ANDERSEN SERVICES PROVIDED Mechanical, Electrical

+ The dining hall included room for more than 16 eateries and 850 diners.

KEY TEAM MEMBERS

+ Mechanically, base building systems were designed to support additional tenant spaces, including plumbing, fire protection, and HVAC systems improvements.

SIZE

+ Key mechanical design features of these systems included capped gas, domestic cold water and sanitary piping, ecology units, make-up air units, and connections for each within tenant spaces.

295,000 sq. ft. (24,250 sq. m.)

+ Electrically, new lighting and security systems upgrades were provided including two new banks of transformers, terminated into a 2000 Amp, double-ended switchboard.

BUDGET \$50 Million

+ A new generator was provided to meet current code and design requirements.

COMPLETION YEAR

+ Third-party smart sub metering was installed, enabling tenants to track their electricity, gas, and water consumption.
