ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Located in a redesigned heritage building, this store is the first free-standing Dolce & Gabbana (D&G) in Canada. The project involved tenant work for both floors of the building.
- + Mechanical design primarily focused on reworking existing roof top units to facilitate a new zone control based enhanced space layout. This included specific acoustical and visibility design criteria, low velocity air distribution, and fully concealed supply air infrastructure.
- + All infrastructure was coordinated with the design architect to ensure that each requirement was mandated by D&G corporate standards.
