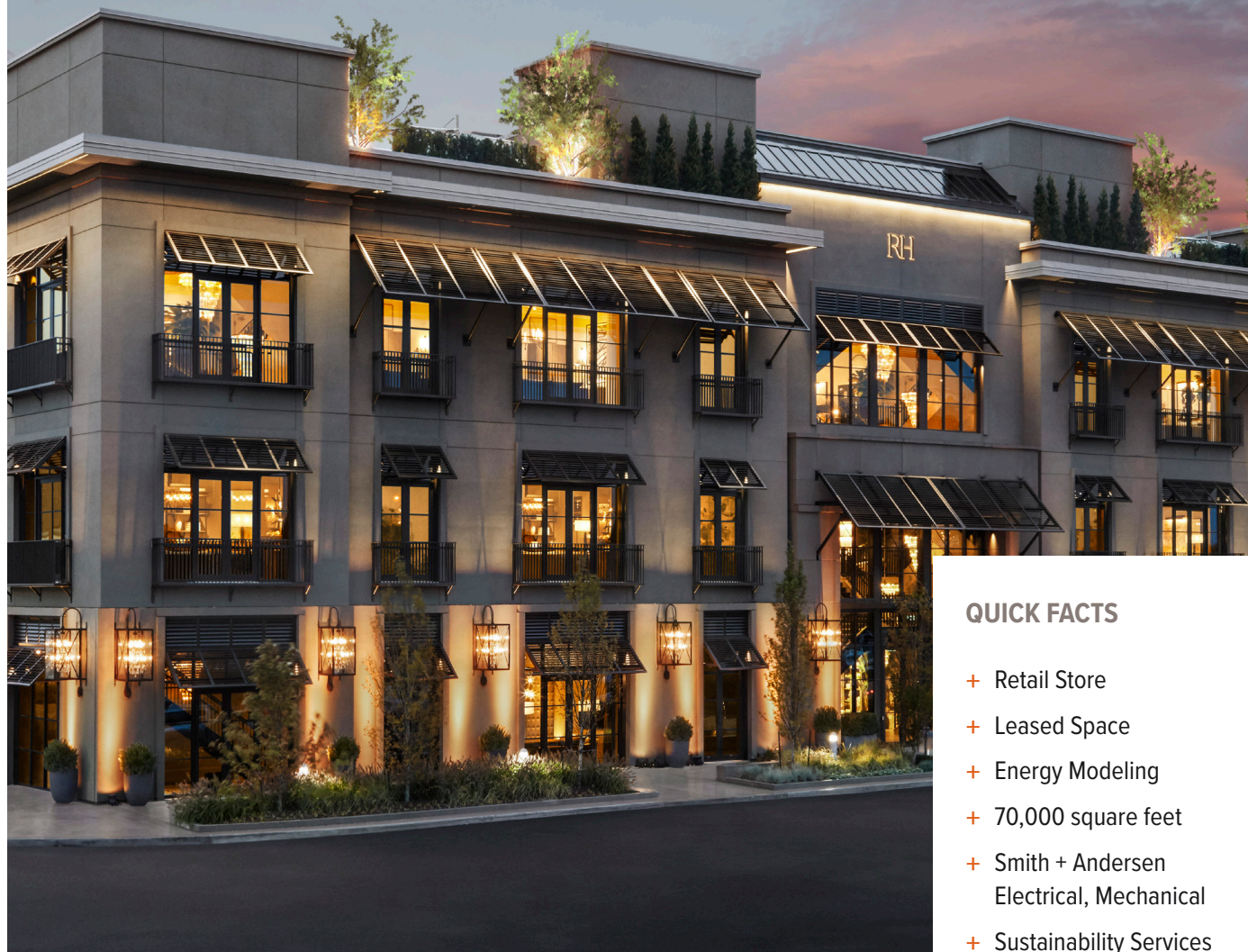

- + The chic furniture retailer creates breathtaking gallery spaces which capture the imaginations of their sophisticated clientele.
- + Each of the four storeys showcases a different area of a shopper's home, with the fourth depicting a beautiful conservatory space displaying elegant outdoor furniture.
- + Smith + Andersen engaged as the mechanical and electrical consultant, providing high performance solutions that do not distract from the lavish, inspirational products displayed.
- + Footprint provided energy modelling which depicted the efficiencies of the designs.
- + Our mechanical team designed a Variable Refrigerant Flow (VRF) system with a make-up air unit (includes an energy recovery unit, which uses fresh air exhausts to recover heat).
- + Pre-heating and pre-cooling outside air provides significant long-term energy savings for the client.
