



SCARBOROUGH TOWN CENTRE FOOD COURT RELOCATION

ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Food court at Scarborough Town Centre was relocated from the upper level of the mall to the lower level.
- + Renovation included a new scullery, a washroom renovation, and new quick service restaurants and retail units.
- + Special consideration was given to reduce impact on existing tenants, and high head room in the lower level.
- + Food court features 22 vendors and approximately 1,000 seats in the dining hall.
- + Each food court vendor is provided with independent control of their supply air and kitchen exhaust, served by the mall's central air handling system.
- + Make-up air is supplemented through the dining hall to maintain occupant comfort and space pressurization.
