

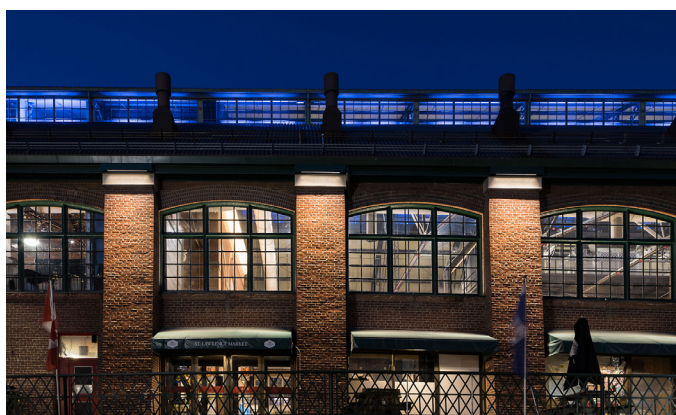

ST. LAWRENCE SOUTH BUILDING HERITAGE LIGHTING UPGRADES

ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Historic St. Lawrence Market, hosting daily farmers' markets and exhibition space for the City of Toronto's Cultural Services.
- + First established in 1803, with the first permanent building constructed in 1820.
- + Engaged as the specialty lighting consultant to revitalize the lighting of this historic building.
- + Utilized a multitude of lighting effects with the latest technology in LED lighting to bring this iconic facade to life.
- + Clerestory area featured colour-changing LED luminaires with different visual effects for special events and celebrations.
- + Incorporated "warm white" lighting on the exterior facades to accent key architectural features, such as windows, cornices, transoms, door arches, roof details, columns, and the main signage.
