











MSH BREAST HEALTH CLINIC RENOVATION

ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Renovation and relocation of the Breast Health Clinic at Markham Stouffville Hospital.
- + Project scope included downsizing and relocating the existing gift shop, and the creation of a new Connected Care space for hospital navigators in the future.
- + Clinic consists of six exam rooms with hand wash sinks, a nurse room, a counselling room, a reception desk and waiting room, and a staff kitchenette.
- + The existing HVAC for the entire area was upgraded to meet CSA Z317.2 standards.
- + Existing medical gas systems were extended to the new exam rooms.
- + Plumbing and drainage was modified to suit hand hygiene sinks, and installation was coordinated with the renovation of the new Orthopaedic Joint Assessment Centre on the floor below to minimize rework.
- + The renovation was completed in phases to allow the gift shop to remain open.
- + Client required all areas to be wheelchair accessible, the available seating in the waiting room to be maximized, and a layout for the new Breast Health Clinic that balanced patient privacy with an open flow between the waiting room and interior clinic areas.
