ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Six-storey mixed use building that winds around a four-storey heritage building—bridging the old and new through existing openings.
- + Located at a prominent corner of Winnipeg's historic East Exchange District, the building includes approx. 170 rental apartments with commercial and surface parking.
- + Heritage building includes a mix of office and residential space, as well as a rooftop deck
- + Plaza acts as amenity space for tenants, as well as public space with programmed activities for residents and visitors.
- Designed the HVAC and plumbing layouts within minimal bulkheads to minimize visibility in order to complement the pre-existing suite design and geometry of the building.
- + Prioritized energy efficiency in both the mechanical and electrical design in order to keep operating costs low for rental units.
- + Implemented a variable refrigerant flow system, which is more effective system than conventional air conditioning systems.
- + Provided an electric heating and cooling solution—a low carbon solution stemming from Manitoba's hydropowered electrical generation.
- + Energy Modelling team evaluated the energy performance of the building relative to the Manitoba Energy Code for Buildings (MECB) 2013.
