



GLENBOW MUSEUM REVITALIZATION

ABOUT THIS PROJECT

- + Redevelopment of existing 45-year old museum in downtown Calgary into a new Contemporary Art Museum featuring Class A and AA climate-controlled spaces.
- + The new museum features gallery spaces for large-scale exhibitions and installations, a restaurant, shop, flexible education areas, and an accessible open-air lobby.
- + Project scope includes revitalization of building exterior facade, the addition of a 5th floor patio/event space, and upgrading the building to meet current code requirements for high buildings.
- + Targeting LEED® Gold.
- + Required modernization and/or replacement of all major mechanical and electrical systems within the facility, including HVAC, plumbing, fire protection, building automation, electrical distribution, lighting, fire alarm, communication, and audio-visual.
- + Mechanical and electrical systems were integrated with the adjacent Calgary TELUS Convention Centre.
- + Phased construction accommodated the museum's collections, which needed fully operational building systems, such as climate control and critical systems, throughout the project .
